Clifford L. Johnson, M.S.P.H., is the director of the Division of Health and Nutrition Examination Surveys (DHANES) in the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). DHANES is responsible for conducting the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES). As the director of DHANES, he is responsible for managing the planning and implementation of methodologic and analytic research for NHANES as well as managing the ongoing/continuous NHANES survey. NHANES data have been instrumental in establishing reference data on health and nutritional status for the United States; important for evaluation of numerous public health programs; critical as a cornerstone of the national nutrition monitoring system; and important in the formulation of health policy on many public health issues (e.g., folic acid fortification, obesity, hypertension, and environmental health). He also has worked extensively in the area of analysis of data from complex sample surveys on the topics of survey design effects, nonresponse bias, multiple imputation, power curves, and the comparison of measurement error versus survey design error. Mr. Johnson received his B.S. in mathematics and statistics from Colorado State University and his M.S.P.H. in biostatistics from the University of North Carolina.
